It's hard to believe that it's already Spring of 2021. Even though the last 12 months have been the hardest times we have ever experienced I am proud of all the things we were able to achieve at Laura's House. I remember too well that we all went into lockdown at home on March 18th and we knew that our clients would need us more than ever.

Sharing the Knowledge

We immediately put safety protocols in place and pivoted within days to offer all our services via Telehealth to our clients. Within weeks our amazing teams of staff began offering our community programs and services remotely with the goal to meet our client population where they were using virtual tools, because they couldn't get to us. We increased our communications with our constituents, and we were able to offer more in-depth information to more people than ever before. A positive outcome from the pandemic is that we have become a national resource for other domestic violence agencies by sharing our knowledge via public platforms. We are proud that we have trained domestic violence advocates across 18 States in the US so far with more being added each month.

The Power of the Journey

Although the momentum slowed during Covid 19, we have now reached \$5.2 M of the \$10 M goal for our Capital Campaign - "The Power of the Journey". It is imperative that we succeed in this endeavor to create the best possible solution for those suffering from domestic violence. The investment required, though significant, will be life changing for those who benefit from the expanded programs and services provided. We need all of our community members to rally around this new facility, located at 33 Journey to provide victims of abuse a central location to receive a multitude of services. INDIVIDUAL, CHILD, COUPLES, & FAMILY THERAPY



Couples Therapy When safe to do so, couples therapy assists in creating

healthier ways

to relate and improves the quality of relationships. Couples have the opportunity to establish better coping skills, new communication styles, and conflict resolution techniques that are necessary to avoid abusive interactions.

GROUP THERAPY

The group will address these questions: How will I know if I'm ready to start dating? How can I avoid getting into another abusive relationship? Why do I seem to attract abusive partners?

LEGAL SERVICES



MEET OUR PRO BONO IMMIGRATION ATTORNEY, CATHERINE NAVARRO.

Catherine joined Laura's House legal department in October 2020 to support survivors of domestic violence with petitioning for VAWA and U-Visa. She is dedicated to our mission to help families break the cycle of domestic violence.

During her short time with Laura's House, she has successfully submitted three immigration relief petitions and supported many individuals understand their legal rights. With her help, Laura's House legal team can offer additional immigration resources to the community.

- We provided legal advocacy services (both in-person and virtually) to 551 clients (518 women and 33 men) including consultations, assistance with temporary restraining and child custody orders, court accompaniment, safety planning, and referrals to other legal services.
- 4,018 units of legal advocacy services were provided.
- **840** hours of volunteer service were donated by Orange County attorneys to assist our clients.
- On a scale of 1 (lowest) to 5 (highest), Legal Advocacy clients overall satisfaction rate was 4.8.



THERAPEUTIC SERVICES

- We provided therapeutic counseling (both in-person and virtually) to 558 new and ongoing clients (491 women, 15 men, and 52 children).
- 3,790 individual and family counseling sessions were conducted.
- **107 clients** received comprehensive case management services.
- 1,845 Personal Empowerment Program (PEP) group service units were provided.
- 331 psycho-educational/life skills group service units were provided.
- 200 alternative therapy activity service units (including EMDR, Sand Tray, Anxiety Reduction Techniques, Art, and Play) were provided.
